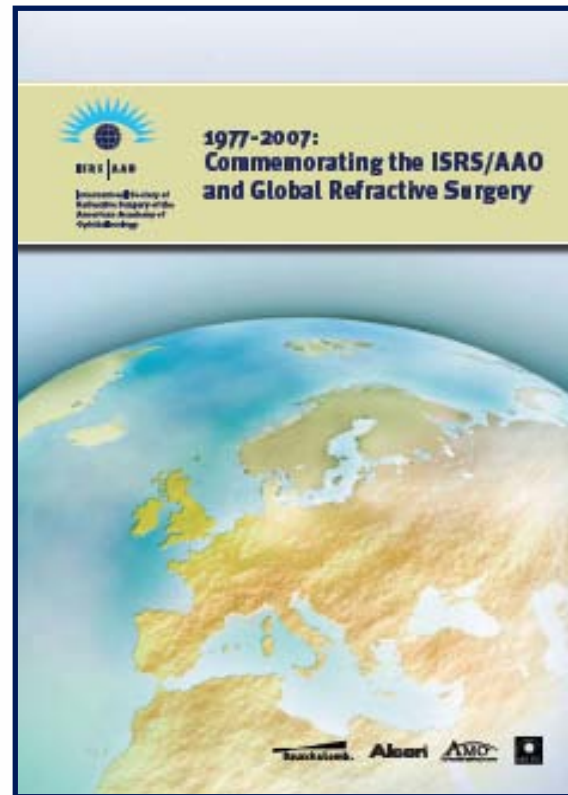

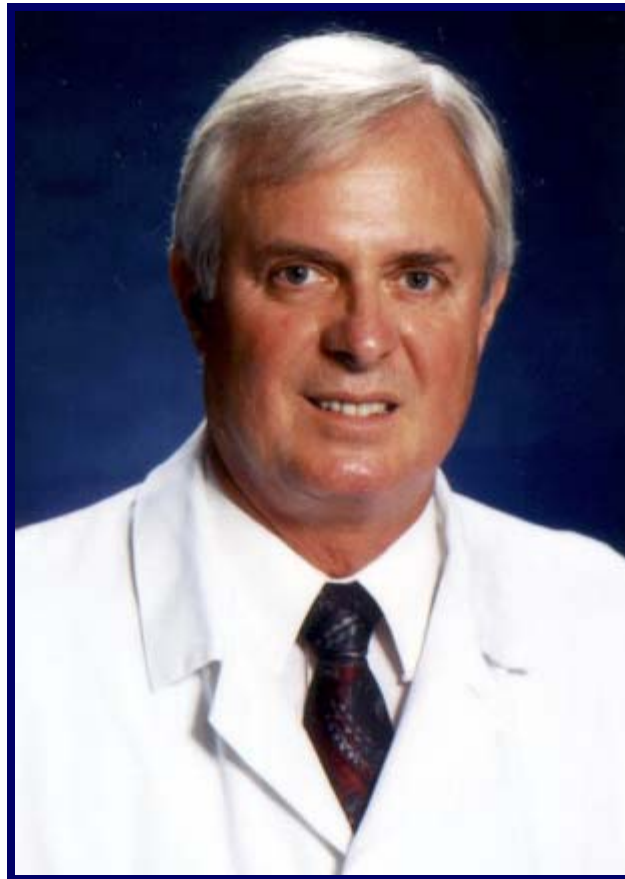

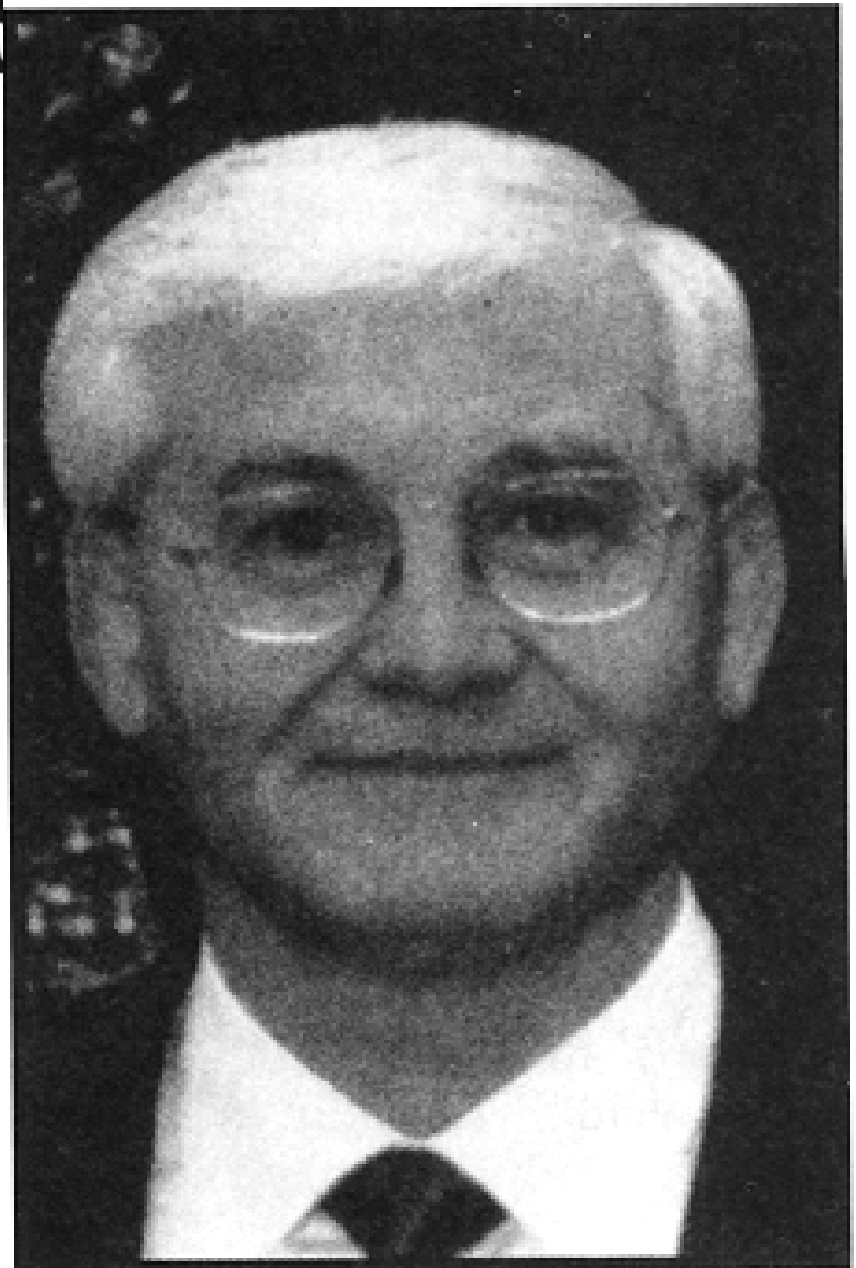
**September 27-30, 1997**

The spring of 2000 found helicopter crashes bringing tragedy and loss to the profession of ophthalmology—at opposite ends of the globe. Michiel Kritzinger, MD and his pilot crashed on his farm near Cape Town, South Africa on April 28, 2000. Shortly thereafter, a helicopter crash killed Svyatoslav N. Fyodorov, MD and three companions on June 2, 2000 in Moscow, just a few miles from his eye institute. The *Journal of Refractive Surgery* and the International Society of Refractive Surgery honor the lives and contributions of these outstanding ophthalmologists.

My personal interactions with Michiel Kritzinger occurred later in our careers and were based on mutual interests in anterior segment surgery at the South African Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery meetings. Refractive surgeons that refractive surgery in South Africa proceeded ahead of much of the world in its innovation because of the dedicated efforts of not only South African ophthalmologists but also a number of faithful American ophthalmologists who fertilized and supported the remarkably diligent refractive surgery work there.

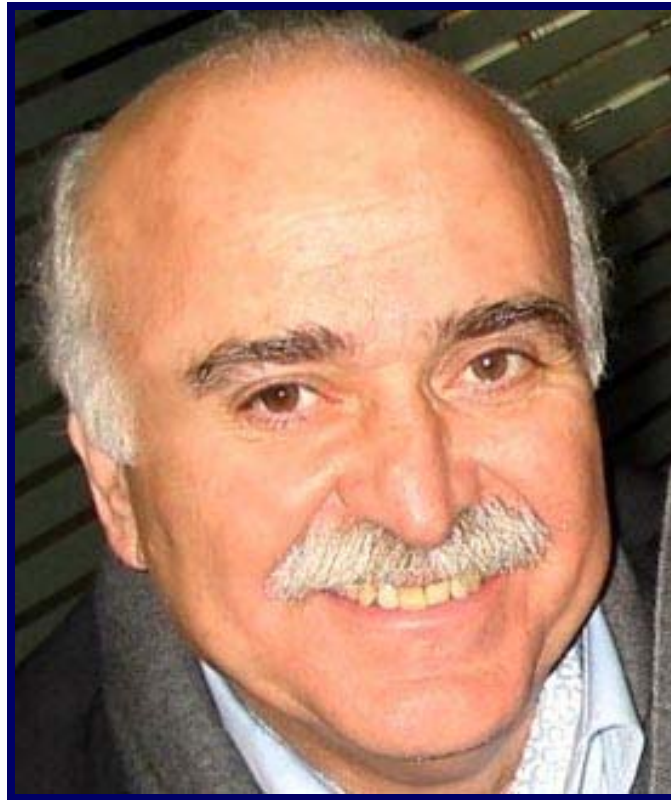

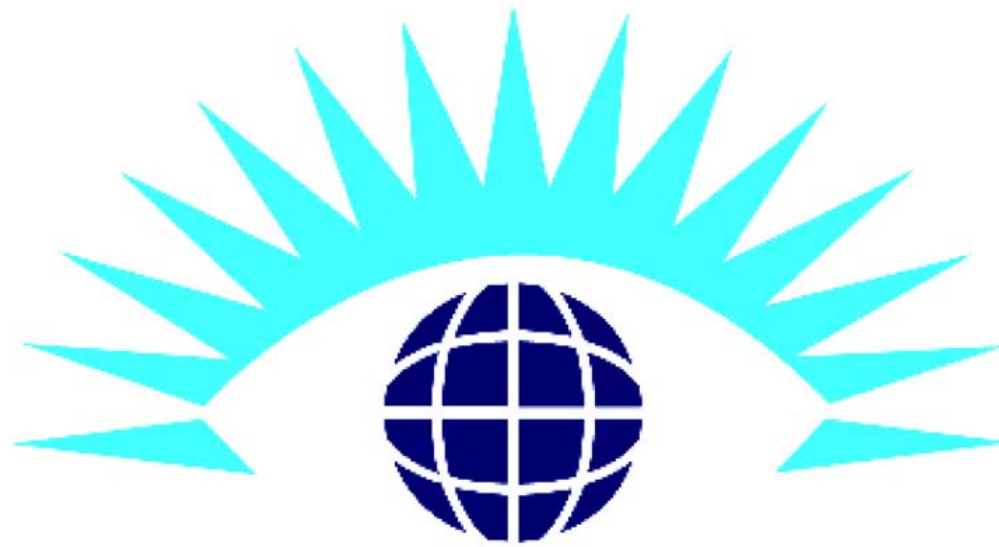
